JIGSAW CLASSROOM STRUCTURES

THE RESCUE WE ALL NEED?

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Traditional classroom environment and structure makes it impossible for students to study, think and act at the same level.

Traditional classroom environment and structure makes it impossible for students to study, think and act at the same level. Some students are left behind while most fall somewhere in the 'average grades' category. Only a select few make it to the top, which helps in boosting their ego through distinctions and scholarships, but for the remaining students, it is demotivating and embarrassing. To add fuel to fire, these classroom models then have issues like bullying, racism, and the like. More or less, the entire classroom model that we follow today has collapsed, so much that now a lot of schools are moving towards alternate methods. Among these alternate models, one quite popular is the 'Jigsaw Classroom Structure'.



What is a Jigsaw Classroom Structure?

Contrary to the general misconception, a Jigsaw Classroom structure is not an 'anything goes' setup, where kids are left to do as they please. Instead, it is a highly cooperative learning technique that thrives on teamwork, interdependence, and collaboration. The main focus is to eliminate discrimination and promote learning, teamwork and most importantly make learning fun. As the name implies, in a Jigsaw Classroom, students are divided into groups and each group is given separate tasks. Each task has multiple parts to it, which are then divided within the group among the students. Each student has to complete their part of the jigsaw to complete the entire task, making it impossible for one to shine brighter than the other. This way, the most intelligent students help their weaker counterparts to achieve their targets. Hence, the overall result is that each student gets a fair chance at learning.

Jigsaw Classrooms promote interdependence and not competition, which is exactly what makes them a whole lot better. In traditional classrooms, students compete with each other, promoting envy and insecurity. On the other hand, in a jigsaw classrooms, students learn the value of teamwork, problem solving and interdependence since even the brightest students have to work with the dullest one to complete their tasks. One for all & all for one!

While the name may make it sound like a puzzle, implementing the Jigsaw Classroom structure is actually quite easy. For any teaching professional, the following 10 steps will be sufficient enough to get going:

1

CREATE GROUPS

Divide students into 6-person group. Make sure each group is diverse in terms of gender, race, and ability.



APPOINT LEADERS

Elect or appoint one person in each group as the leader. Ideally, this person should be the most mature or capable among the students.

3

SEGMENTED ASSIGNMENTS

Divide the homework or classwork in the 6 parts. For instance, if you want your students to learn about Abraham Lincoln, you should divide the segments as: 1. Childhood, 2. Education, 3. Early Life, 4. Political Life & Achievements, 5. Demise & Legacy and 6. In Popular Culture.



ASSIGN TO STUDENTS

Assign each part of the assignment to each student and ensure that each student has access to only their designated segment.

FAMILIARITY EXERCISE

Let the students read the assignment segment within a certain period of time and let them get familiar with it.



EXPERT GROUPS

Create a temporary expert group by picking one student from each jigsaw group and allowing them to discuss their assignment points and rehearse how they will present it to their jigsaw group members.

BACK TO JIGSAW GROUPS

Bring the experts back to their jigsaw groups.



PRESENT ASSIGNMENTS

Ask each student to introduce their assignment segment to their group members and encourage other students to ask questions for clarity.

INVIGILANCE

Invigilate each group to see if there is any disruption or confusion. If found, make an intervention and encourage the group leader to handle such matters.



SESSION END

Now the session should end and each group should be ready for a quiz. The quiz will allow you to score the groups based on their learning.
